Are you tired of spending your vacations in nice hotels? Would you rather eat raw coconuts and fish instead of gourmet meals? If so, the Spanish travel company Docastaway may be for you.

Docastaway will send you to a remote island in the ocean. You'll have to find your own food and build your own shelter. You'll also have to fend off whatever animals may be lurking in the jungle.

Travelers can choose from 16 deserted islands. These islands are located in places like the Philippines, Indonesia, and Central America. Travelers will be given fishing equipment and machetes.

Less adventurous travelers can choose an island with a ready-built shelter. Tents, cottages, tree houses, and bungalows are available for people who don't want to build their own shelter.

To guarantee maximum isolation, each island is limited to one person or one couple at a time.

Guests can stay on these islands for up to 40 days. Most adventurers say that two weeks is the ideal stay.

Having the real castaway experience isn't cheap. Seven days on one of these remote islands costs around \$1,600 for two people. And that doesn't include airfare!
